
RUTGERS FILMMAKING TASCAM DR-40 CHEAT SHEET



- 1) Place 3 AA batteries into the back of your recorder and power it on by pressing the **POWER/HOME** button on the front of the device.
- 2) Normalize your audio recorder by setting it back to factory default. This is only important if the last user was not you.

MENU>OTHERS>SYSTEM>INTITIALIZE

2) Insert and format your SD card. Caution, this will erase any data previously saved! Formatting before use decreases the chances that you'll have card errors during recording.

MENU>OTHERS>SYSTEM>FULL FORMAT

3) Select your recording format and sampling rate.

MENU>REC SETTINGS>FORMAT>WAV 24bit
MENU>REC SETTINGS>SAMPLE>48k

4) For location shoots, it is recommended to use a LOW CUT filter to reduce wind and handling noise.

MENU>REC SETTINGS>LOW CUT>80Hz

5) Adjust the built-in microphones facing toward each other for XY stereo recording (more directional phantom center).

6) Hit the record button so it is flashing red and adjust your gain using the **INPUT LEVEL** buttons (27) on the side of the device so that your levels average around -18db (look for the little black triangle as your target marker).





- 7) Adjust your headphone volume to a comfortable level using the +/- buttons on the front of the device.
- 8) Now hit the **RECORD BUTTON** again to record audio. Confirm that your timecode is moving.

OPTIONAL: You may also combine the built in microphones with external microphones (such a lavalier and/or shotgun mics) using **FOUR CHANNEL** recording.



- 9) Plug external mic(s) into INPUT 1/2 on the bottom of the device.
- 10) Turn the EXT IN switch (25) on the side of the device to MIC+PHANTOM



11) Press the **REC MODE** on the front of the device and select the following:

REC MODE>4CH EXT IN>EXT INDEP
